

Dearborn Baseball Travel Rules

1. All travel team coaches are selected by the executive board.
2. All travel teams must hold at least one tryout per year. Tryout dates and times must be advertised on the web site as well as in the Press & Guide. House league coaches must also be notified.
3. Residency Rule: All travel team players must meet one of the following qualifications, 1) be a resident of Dearborn 2) attend a school within the Dearborn school district 3) have played in the Dearborn Baseball house league in the past.
4. All travel players must pay the \$200 fee to the league and completely fill out the Dearborn Baseball application and waiver. Birth certificates must be provided to the coach.
5. Travel players may also play in the house league during the same season. *This is not mandatory but is strongly recommended!* The player must pay the fee for house league in addition to the fee for travel.
6. Play time is within the complete discretion of the coach.
7. Maximum three assistant coaches.
8. Travel players are allowed to “play up” and are encouraged to “play up” where appropriate.
9. There will be no travel teams age nine or younger!
10. Any 10 and Under “travel” team will take its players from the house leagues only and play in tournaments in addition to house baseball.
